### St Aloysius Sports Day – Year 7, 8 & 9 Monday the 9 July 2018

On Monday the 9<sup>th</sup> of July the year 7, 8 & 9 students at St Aloysius College will be taking part in Sports Day at the School playing fields.

Pupils must arrive at school and be present in their forms for the usual time of 8.45 am. Once registered, they will be escorted down to the school fields by members of staff. Prior to leaving school, the students who require free school meals will be given a packed lunch in the canteen. Those who do not require free school meals are advised to bring their own packed lunch for the day. Students should take their bags into school as usual to carry their lunch.

Each student is expected to wear full school PE kit for the whole day including a comfortable pair of trainers. Water will be provided for students throughout the day. However, it would be wise for the students to take their own water bottle with them to ensure they stay hydrated. On that note, the use of sun cream is highly recommended for the students who suffer in hot conditions.

The day is due to finish at 2.00 pm when students will be dismissed in their form groups from the school fields. As there will be over 500 students involved in this event, it is essential that your son is well behaved to ensure the day runs smoothly. This includes exemplary behaviour when walking to the fields, participating in the days activities and after being dismissed to return home.

There will also be a refreshments stall available throughout the day where students can purchase food or extra drinks. The proceeds from the stall will contribute towards supporting the development of young athletes within Physical Education.
