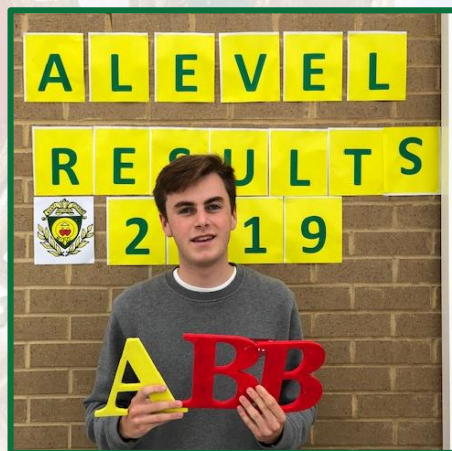
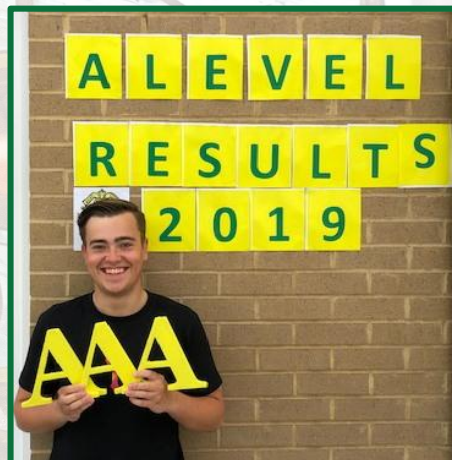

## Year-on -Year Improvement in A Level Results

Building on the success of improvements in educational outcomes at St Aloysius' College, students and staff at the school celebrated excellent results. A key measure, the percentage of A\*-B grades, were a pleasing 29%, A\*C grades again improved and A\*E grades were also an impressive 100%, well above national outcomes.

Exceptional performances were seen in Maths with 30% A\*A grades. Equally pleasing were very strong A\*B grades in Chemistry (75%), Spanish (50%), Sociology (46%), and English Language (37%).

Ms Heffernan, Executive Headteacher, stated that 'It is tremendously rewarding to see the hard work of staff and students come together to secure these fantastic outcomes.' Mr English, Associate Headteacher, was delighted to see the impact of the work of the school this year and how this has enabled students to secure their aspirations at university and in work.
