#### Component 1 - Literary Genres – Aspects of Tragedy

One Shakespeare tragedy, one pre-1900 text and one modern drama text. Currently: *Othello*, Keats' selected poetry and Miller's *Death of a Salesman* 

Component 2 - Elements of Crime Writing

One post 2000 prose text, one pre 1900 poetry text and one further text.

Currently: McEwan's Atonement, Crabbe, Browning and Wilde poetry, Christie's The Murder of Roger Ackroyd

Component 3 – Theory and Independence

Student selected texts and tasks under guidance of teacher – students must study one prose and one poetry text
