WELCOME BACK LETTER FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-24

Dear Parents,

I hope you and your families are keeping well and that you enjoyed a restful summer break.

I am very pleased to share our 2023 A-Level and GCSE Public exam results with you. Despite top grades falling nationally at A-Level to bring results back in line with 2019, our top grades increased at A-Level with our pupils securing 20 A*-A grades, 62% A*-B grades, 90% A*-C grades and 100% A*-E grades. Most students secured their first preferences and have accepted places at top universities, including 33% at the prestigious Russell Group Universities. We are delighted for them and very proud of their achievements.

GCSE exam results were also very strong with 27% grades 7-9 (grades A-A**), 59% grades 5+ (B-) 73% grades 4+ (C), 74% grades 4+ in Mathematics and 81% grades 4+ in English.

David Baah Okyere achieved a full sweep of grade 9's and six boys achieved grades 7-9 in their ten GCSE subjects. Michael Mamattah secured a fully funded Sixth Form scholarship to Highgate Public school having secured top GCSE results.

GCSE results have improved significantly since 2019 and are well above national for both mixed schools and for boys' schools.
