## **Other Charges**

## **Examination Fees**

The school will pay for the public examinations for which it prepares students, except in any of the following circumstances:

- (i) The student has failed to complete the minimum level of coursework required to achieve a grade.
- (ii) The student's attendance is a cause for concern and the school believes s/he is unlikely to attend the examination.
- (iii) At GCE 'A' level, if the teacher is unable to recommend entry on the basis of the student's inability to achieve a grade.
- (iv) At GCE 'A' level for second or subsequent modular test re-sits.

However, in circumstances (i), (ii) and (iii) parents/carers may be asked to pay the examination fee, as set by the relevant Examination Board. This will be refunded by the school if a grade is achieved. Extra-Curricular Activities Parents/Carers will be asked to contribute to the cost of repairing / replacing books, classroom resources and apparatus or equipment damaged by those students for whom they are responsible.

## **Extra-Curricular Activities**

Parents/carers will be asked to contribute to the cost of repairing/replacing books, classroom resources and apparatus or equipment damages by those students for whom they are responsible and which are not part of the compulsory curriculum.

Parents/Students who use credit cards (not Debit) to make payments via ParentPay will be charged an additional sum per transaction.
