Re: Year 7 arrangements for the new term

The induction day is now completed and I hope that your son met lots of new people and is feeling confident about starting Year 7.

I wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of the arrangements for the Autumn Term. We expect Year 7 students to be in school promptly at **8.25am on Wednesday 4th September 2019**. All students must enter and exit the school premises through the back or side gates. Your son will have seen these on his tour. The back gates are locked daily at 8.35am and any late students must enter through the side gates and have their names recorded for a late detention.

On arrival, Year 7 students should go to the playground where they will be collected by their form tutor and escorted to their new form room. Please also ensure that the following preparations are in place:

- Full school uniform including a white striped tie and lace up shoes. Winter coats are not compulsory however if your son chooses to wear one it must have the schools logo and can be purchased from Rough Cuts.
- A fully equipped pencil case including at least 3 black pens, pencils, ruler, highlighter pens and a calculator
- PE kit
- You have read the induction work booklet and visited the school website

Year 7 students will spend the first part of the day with their tutors getting timetables, planners, ID cards and receiving any other essential information. There will also be a reading test on the first day.

If your son is not bringing a packed lunch, please ensure that you have put money on our son's **Parentpay** account so he can purchase lunch. Your son's ID card will also function as his lunch card in the canteen. ID cards can also be topped up with cash from one of our machines in the canteen. If you have access to free school meals, please ensure you have registered in good time before September (see Islington council website).

The school day will **finish at 3.05pm** as normal and students must exit through the back gates.

We hope you have a wonderful summer and we look forward to seeing you in September to begin a new chapter at St Aloysius College
