REMINDER: LATE OPENING – FRIDAY 1ST NOVEMBER 2019 – ALL SAINTS DAY

It has been a busy first half term and this continues with a determined push for our Year 11 and Year 13 students who are already facing the mock examinations starting next week. AP1 tests for Years 7-10 will commence week beginning 18th November 2019. These will be formal assessments, please ensure your son is revising in advance.

A reminder that students are expected to attend Mass in their own Parish on Friday as it is a Holy Day of Obligation (All Saints Day) and thereafter, students are expected to arrive at school before 10.40am as the gates will close promptly at this time. Students are then to go immediately to their Form Rooms for registration at 10.50am. The first lesson will commence at period 3. The 10.40am break time canteen service will not be available.

As you may be aware, Remembrance Sunday Service is taking place at the school at 10.00am on Sunday 10th November 2019 to be followed by the laying of the wreaths at the War Memorial, adjacent to the school. You are warmly invited to attend.

I also remind you as the colder and darker days arrive that no child in Year 7 is permitted to wear a coat that is not official St Aloysius uniform. Years 8 - 11 are permitted to wear a plain black coat.

All students should also leave site and **go straight home**, not frequenting the fast food shops or be seen in the surrounding areas in uniform unless on their journey home. It is for their own safety and to ensure that the Archway and the surrounding area remains a clean safe environment for all.
