Dear Students,

I sincerely hope you are all keeping well under these strange and unprecedented circumstances. As you are aware, the school site is closed to most students until further notice; the exception being for vulnerable students and students whose parents are key workers.

What I, Ms Heffernan and the staff of St Aloysius would like from you, other than staying safe is that you should continue to access work remotely via SMH. Subject teachers, Heads of Year and SLT are monitoring that you are accessing work. Try as far as possible to maintain some structure to your day and that you are accessing the work programme. This will help you once we return to school. Attached is an outline of what you should complete.

If you are having any problems accessing Show My Homework, please email Mr Brown at enquiries@sta.islington.sch.uk to reset passwords, or for reminders of usernames.

I also urge you all to follow the guidance issued by the Government:

In short:

You should only leave the house for one of three reasons:

- Shopping for basic necessities, for example food and medicine, which must be as infrequent as possible.
- One form of exercise a day, for example, a run, walk, or cycle - alone or with members of your household.
- Any medical need, or to provide care or to help a vulnerable person.

These three reasons are exceptions - even when doing these activities, you should be minimising time spent outside of the home and ensuring you are two metres apart from anyone outside of your household. By behaving in a responsible way and following this guidance, we in the St Aloysius community will be doing our bit in supporting the country to deal with this terrible virus.

At this difficult time please support each other in our school community and I look forward to the day when we are all back together as a school. Until then, stay safe, follow the guidance and stay healthy.
