

Safer Working Visitors Protocols

To ensure that the school community remains safe, all visitors MUST adhere to the following protocols:

Our school will welcome visitors if:

- The visitor is not at risk of bringing coronavirus into the school. You should not come into the school if you currently need to self-isolate, according to the <u>latest government guidance</u>, if you:
 - Are displaying any coronavirus symptoms (a new continuous cough, a high temperature, or a loss or change in your sense of taste and/or smell)
- All visitors must follow the measures the school has put in place to minimise the spread of coronavirus, for example:
 - Visitors must use the hand sanitiser provided on their arrival and before leaving the building
 - Visitors must also wash their hands thoroughly with soap and water for 20 seconds where possible
 - Visitors must wear a face covering in areas of the school where social distancing isn't possible, such as corridors, unless you are exempt from wearing one.
 - Providing contact details for the school, in case the school needs to contact you
 following public health advice in the event of a coronavirus outbreak within the school
 community
